About the Job

Under general supervision, responsible for installation, maintenance and repair of industrial electrical equipment and electronic controls within all airport terminals, buildings, parking lots, and related facilities.

Responsibilities

Performs electrical maintenance on all electrical systems, electronic controls, transformers, generators, and switch gears including maintaining records on work performed. Works on medium voltage systems and equipment.

Uses blueprints, schematics, drawings, and electrical code specifications in order to effectively troubleshoot, install, maintain and repair equipment.

Prepares and assembles conduits. Performs testing on electrical systems and circuits in electrical wiring, equipment, and fixtures using electrical testing devices to ensure compatibility and safety of system.

Operates tools and equipment needed to perform work and operates portable radios for communication.

Researches availability and cost for replacement parts, completes requisitions, and inventories stock parts and equipment.

Requirements

KNOWLEDGE - High school diploma or GED. Memphis-Shelby County Master or Journeyman Electrical License. Must obtain Class II AOA license within 24 months of employment.

Four (4) years Journeyman Electrician experience to include industrial electrical experience in medium voltage, switch gears, generators, or transformers. Thorough knowledge of National Electric Code and Memphis-Shelby County Joint Electrical Code. Ability to read and interpret specifications, blueprints, electrical schematics, drawings and sketches. Knowledge of office software applications, such as Microsoft Word. Good written, verbal, and communication skills. Must have a valid driver license.

Will have thorough knowledge of National Electric Code and Memphis-Shelby County Joint Electrical Code and must have their Memphis-Shelby County Master or Journeyman's Electrical License.
